Day 01 SINGAPORE → INCHEON

Assemble at Changi International Airport for your flight to Incheon.

Day 02 INCHEON

Lunch

Upon arrival, visit the **Le Space Inspire**, Korea's largest immersive media art exhibit where visitors can experience cutting-edge digital media entertainment. Next, **Song-dong Fairy Tales Village**, which features paintings of famous fairy tales. **Jajangmyeon Museum** - presents the birth of Jajangmyeon, the black bean noodles.
