The **Blue House**, for decades a symbol of power in South Korea, is now the country's latest tourist hot spot. **Bukchon Hanok Village** in Seoul is home to over 900 traditional Korean houses (hanok) dated back to Joseon Dynasty. **Ikseon-dong Street** is the hipster place of Seoul. It is certainly one of the trendiest and most up and coming neighbourhoods in Seoul. **Dongdaemun Market** is Korea's largest wholesale and retail shopping district.
