## Day 01 SINGAPORE → MADRID

*Meals on Board*

- Assemble at Changi International Airport to check in for your flight to **Madrid**, Spain.

## Day 02 MADRID

*Meal on Board / Dinner*

- Commence on a **Madrid** city tour, drive around to see the **Cibeles Fountain**, **Gran Via**, **Real Madrid Stadium** and stop for photos at the **Royal Palace**. If time permits, you can enjoy some shopping at the exclusive Salamanca District.

## Day 03 MADRID

*Breakfast*

- Today, you may wish to join an optional tour to the former capital, Toledo. Embark on a guided walking tour of the medieval city to see sights of the Alcazar and Gothic Cathedral from the hill. Make a stop at the El Corte Inglés Castellana, Spain's leading department store with the highest tax refund rate in Europe. *(Note: Visit is subject to opening days/times)*

## Day 04 MADRID → SEGOVIA → SALAMANCA

*Breakfast / Roast Suckling Pig Lunch / Dinner*

- Proceed to the **old town** of **Segovia** for a view of its **Roman Aqueduct Bridge**, both of which are listed as UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Taste the famous local specialty of **Roast Suckling Pig**, 'Cochinillo Asado' for lunch. En route, we will stop for photos at **Avila**, the most well-preserved medieval city wall. Make a stop at **Salamanca's Plaza Mayor**, regarded as one of the finest squares in Europe.



## Day 05 SALAMANCA → PORTO

*Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner-Piri Piri Chicken with Wine*

- This morning, we shall cross the border into **Porto**, the 2nd largest city in Portugal and a UNESCO World Heritage City. Commence the guided city tour of Porto and see the **Porto Cathedral**, **Igreja do Carmo**, **Aliados Ave** and **Dom Luis Bridge**. You will get the chance to sample and savour world-famous **Port Wine**.

## Day 06 PORTO → FATIMA → LISBON

*Breakfast / Dinner*

- Travel to Serra d' Aire Mountains to the **Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima**, the world-renowned centre of pilgrimage in the Catholic world. Tonight, we will stay the night in the capital of Portugal, **Lisbon**.

## Day 07 LISBON

*Breakfast / Portuguese Egg Tart Snack*

- Lisbon's sightseeing starts with the broad avenues of the lower town and the alleys of the **Alfama Quarter**. View the **Monument to the Discoveries**, the **Belem Tower** and **Jeronimos Monastery** and not forgetting to stop for the ever-popular snacks – **Portuguese Egg Tarts**.

This afternoon, you may wish to consider joining an optional tour to visit Sintra, the westernmost point of continental Europe at Cabo Da Roca, and the charming fishing village of Cascais.

## Day 08 LISBON → SEVILLE

*Breakfast / Lunch / Flamenco Dinner Show with Wine*

- Cross the border back into Spain to the capital of Andalusia - **Seville**, and see the immense 15th century gothic **Seville Cathedral** with its slender Giralda Tower. Walk through **Maria Luisa Park** to the beautiful square of **Plaza de Espana**. See the Jewish District of **Santa Cruz** with its flower-decked wrought iron balconies. Tonight, enjoy a fiery **Flamenco Dinner Show with wine** for an unforgettable experience of Spanish passion!

## Day 09 SEVILLE → GRANADA

*Breakfast / Dinner*

- Today, you may wish to join an excursion to Cordoba, which was an important Roman city and a major Islamic centre during the Middle Ages. See the Mezquita de Cordoba – the Mosque-Cathedral has been an important place to the Islamic community of Al-Andalus for 3 centuries.

We will drive to the southern Spain's Andalusia region, **Granada**, in the foothills of Sierra Nevada Mountains. Enjoy its little streets and alleys, full of Andalusian atmosphere and character. Embark on a guided walking tour through the whitewashed historic quarter of **Albaicin** with its narrow lanes and a **fantastic view of Granada and Alhambra Palace** from **Mirador San Nicholas**.

## Day 10 GRANADA 🚌 VALENCIA

*Breakfast / Seafood Paella Dinner*

- This morning, we will drive through the Sierra Mountains en route to **Guadix**, best known as the 'City of Caves'. We will visit one of the cave houses in Guadix. Drive along the scenic coastline to **Valencia**, the 3rd largest city in Spain. Drive through the **old town of Valencia** and stop at the **City of Art and Sciences**, one of the largest scientific and cultural complexes in Europe.

## Day 11 VALENCIA 🚌 BARCELONA

*Breakfast*

- Shop to your heart's content and enjoy some outlet shopping at **La Roca Village**, discover exclusive pieces, best sellers at 140+ designer brands of up to 60% off the recommended retail price, all year round!

*(Note: Visit is subject to opening days/times)*

## Day 12 BARCELONA

*Breakfast / Tapas Lunch with Sangria*

- Drive past **Columbus Monument**, **Las Ramblas** and **Plaça de Catalunya**. View the facades of UNESCO-listed Gaudi masterpieces such as **Casa Batlló** and **Casa Milà**. Next, stop for photos at Montjuic Hill, a prominent hill overlooking the **Barcelona Harbour**. Visit the 130 years-old, still unfinished mammoth church of **La Sagrada Familia**. *(Note: Entry is subject to the opening days/times)*. Enjoy your free time in the **Catalunya Plaza**, one of the largest squares in Spain, explore the most bustling places with endless shops and cafes in **Las Ramblas** and **Passeig de Gracia**! You may consider joining an optional tour to visit the unique and holy mountain of Montserrat with spectacular mountain views, ancient monastery, and its renowned holy shrine.

## Day 13 BARCELONA → SINGAPORE

*Breakfast*

- Bid farewell to Spain and transfer to the airport for our flight back to Singapore. We hope that you have had an enjoyable time with SA Tours!
