### D1: SINGAPORE → SHANGHAI → HANGZHOU (2H+ -) (Dinner-Hangzhou Beggar Chicken Flavor)

Assemble at airport for your flight to **Shanghai**. Proceed to **Hangzhou**, the most beautiful city in the world, as once described by the great Italian traveler, Marco Polo.

**\*Hangzhou; West Lake Scenic Area, Changqiao Park**  
*\*Compulsory Tour to Hefang Street in Ming and Qing Dynasties, visit the Ancient architectural streets in Song Dynasty.*

### Day 2 : HANGZHOU → THOUSAND ISLAND LAKE → TUNXI (3.5H +) (Breakfast / Lunch-Qiandao Lake Fish Head Flavor )

**\*Today, enjoy a Qiandao Scenic Area Lake (Thousand Island Lake) Cruise.**(city lake area), one of the world's three "Thousand Island Lakes", with 1078 large and small islands, beautiful scenery.

*\*Compulsory Tour to Hongcun ancient village* has been labelled a World Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO well-known as the "Village in the Painting" and has the best preserved Ming and Qing dwellings. Thereafter coach on to **Tunxi**.

**\*Take a stroll around the famous Tunxi Old Street,** where there is a picture of the Riverside during the Qingming Festival. Proceed to the **Gourmet Street** for dinner *at your own expenses.*

### Day 3: TUNXI → WUYUAN (1H+-) → TUNXI (1.5H+-) (Breakfast/Lunch)

Move on to **Wuyuan**, known as the most beautiful countryside in China.

**\*Huangling Scenic Area (includes cable car) ;** This village is full of an atmosphere of simplicity and elegance. Built on a hillside, houses in Huangling Village have a unique characteristic "U" shape. "Dry Crops In Autumn" has become a typical symbol of local culture, this special and interesting scene attracts more and more visitors to tour and take photographs there.

*Compulsory Tour to Liyang Water Street Food Street;*  
**Dinner at Food Street** *at your own expenses.*

**Day 4: WUYUAN ⇄ HUANGSHAN (1H+-) (include Huangshan 2way cable car ride) (Breakfast /Lunch/Dinner)**

\*Tour **Huangshan**; Enjoy a Cable Car Ride to Mt. Huangshan Scenic Area , reputed to be the 'number one mountain under heaven'. With 72 peaks, 2 waterfalls and 24 streams, Huangshan is lined with pine trees with fascinating shapes, rocks with strange contours, sea of mist, clouds and hot springs which make up the 4 wonders of Huangshan .Visit scenic area - Danxia Peak, Paiyun Pavilion, Immortal drying boots, Tiangou listening to the piano,couples talking stone etc.

**Day 5: HUANGSHAN ⇄ HANGZHOU(3H+-) (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)**

Try to get up early this morning to catch the **Magical \*Sunrise**. It's the most splendid period of the day as the rising sun lights up the sky and it seems like the whole world takes on a brilliant glow. Continue to visit "Huangshan Scenic Area" Lion Peak, overlooking the West Sea Grand Canyon, Black Tiger Pine, Sanhuawu, and Shixin Peak. Enjoy the scenery along the way Thereafter , **descend Huangshan by cable car**.

\*Return to Hangzhou; visit **Xixi Wetland Scenic Area (including Boat ride + battery car)**.

\*Visit **Yanshui Yuzhuang, Shentankou Scenic Area** (*\*Note: All natural phenomena are subject to weather conditions and thus beyond human control*).

**Day 6:HANGZHOU ⇄ SHANGHAI(3H+-) (Breakfast /Lunch-mini hot pot)**

\***Beijing-Hangzhou Grand Canal**; known as the Jing–Hang Grand Canal, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is the longest canal or artificial river in the world.

\***Xiaohezhi Street Historical and Cultural Street**

\*view **The Bund** in coach ;is the important landmarks of Shanghai. The Bund is famous for its grand,Western-style buildings that were built in the late 19th and early 20th Centuries.The buildings feature architectural styles from Neoclassical to Beaux-Arts to Gothic to Baroque.

\*Visit **Shanghai Nanjing Road** ; **one of the world's busiest shopping streets**.

**Day 7:SHANGHAI (Breakfast/Dinner)**

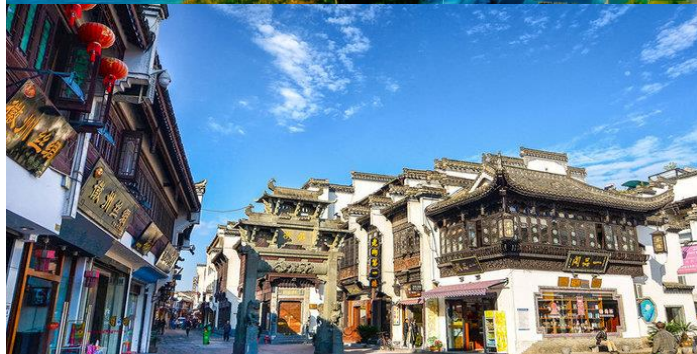
\***Lujiazui Sky Corridor**: the best to take photos of the four tallest buildings in Shanghai.

\***Shanghai Guangfulin Cultural Site-Underwater Museum, Fulin Tower**.



**Day 8:SHANGHAI→SINGAPORE(Breakfast)**

**Compulsory Tour** : shopping in **Chenghuang Temple shopping street** –thereafter transfer to the airport for Your flight back to Singapore.
