## DAY 1: SINGAPORE – SHANGHAI

## DAY 2: SHANGHAI – SUZHOU – SHANGHAI

Upon arrival in Shanghai, begin your day with a visit to **Tongli**, a picturesque water town with over a thousand years of history, often called the "Little Venice Water Town." This ancient town showcases the architectural beauty of the Ming and Qing dynasties with its charming riverside houses. Next, head to **Suzhou**, known as the "Oriental Venice" for its intricate canal network. Explore the **Master of the Nets Garden**, a UNESCO Cultural Heritage site. Then, drive by **Jingji Lake**, take in views of the Suzhou Bird Nest, and admire the striking exterior of the Gate of the Orient. Conclude the day with a coach ride back to Shanghai .

## DAY 3 : SHANGHAI

Take a leisurely walk through the **Chenghuangmiao Commercial District**. Afterwards, venture to **Tianzifang**, a tourist-centric arts and crafts enclave that has transformed from a renovated traditional residential area in the French Concession of Shanghai. Following that, explore **The Bund**, a waterfront area and a preserved historical district in central Shanghai. To cap off the evening, enjoy experience of a **Shanghai Huangpu River Cruise**. ### DAY 5: SHANGHAI – TOKYO ( NARITA )

### DAY 6 : NARITA - MT FUJI - TOKYO

While en route to Tokyo, stop at **Arakurayama Sengen Park**, a world-renowned spot for breathtaking views of Mount Fuji. In spring, the park's iconic five-storied pagoda framed by cherry blossoms creates a uniquely Japanese scene with Mount Fuji in the background. The park offers stunning views of the mountain in every season. Next, enjoy a photo stop at Fujiyoshida's **Honcho Street**, one of the most Instagram-worthy sites for capturing Mount Fuji . Continue to **Gotemba Premium Outlets**, Japan's most popular outlet mall, where luxury meets local brands for an unforgettable shopping experience. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

**Fuji Shibazakura Festival (Pink Moss):** Immerse yourself in the Fuji Shibazakura Festival, a celebration featuring the vibrant moss phlox flower set against the backdrop of Mount Fuji. With over 800,000 moss phlox (shibazakura) adorning the landscape, it promises a spectacular experience.

### DAY 7 : TOKYO

Embark on a delightful journey today at Tokyo , Our local guide bring will let experience the local rapid train transport for City tour . (1D **Tokyo Metro unlimited Pass**) will be provided . Morning will be visiting the **Ameyako shopping District** - More than 400 stores line this busy market street that sits under

the rail line between JR Ueno and Okachimachi stations. Shops sell seafood, clothing, dried food, Afternoon will be heading to **Shibuya Shopping District** , Here you can enjoy the Numerous department stores and shopping malls can be found around the area catering to all types of shoppers. you can also see the world-famous **Shibuya scramble crossing** is an experience that should not be missed when in Tokyo .
