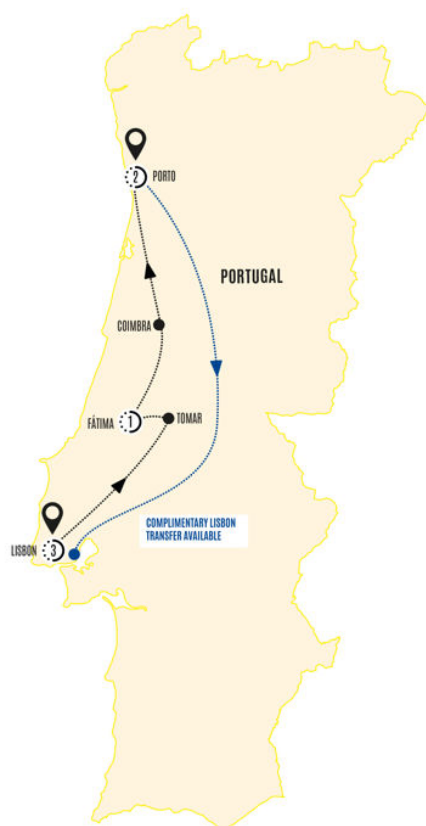


Picturesque Portugal End Porto

Day 1 | Arrive Lisbon



Pastel and azulejo-clad facades line Lisbon's narrow streets which ramble across and over its seven hills from St. George Castle to the Tagus River. Gaze over the Portuguese capital's terracotta rooftops, soaking up its small-town atmosphere before kicking off your adventure later this evening. Tonight you'll join your Travel Director and fellow travellers for dinner and sample some of the local favourites that you'll encounter throughout your journey across Portugal.

Day 2 | Lisbon sightseeing and free time



Explore the Age of the Discoveries and Portugal's role as a global maritime power many centuries ago when you join a Local Specialist for a sightseeing tour. The Golden Triangle: Estoril, Cascais and Sintra - Step out of Lisbon and into the magic of the region's top spots with your Local Guide. Then, cap off your "Golden Triangle" tour with a visit to one of Portugal's stunning Royal Palaces, tucked away in the Sintra Mountains.

Day 3 | Lisbon free day



Que bom! A full free day in Lisboa to explore the enchanting Portuguese capital your way. The secret to living a long life lies in eating a big breakfast, but as you'll come to discover in Lisbon that may extend to a big lunch and dinner too. Spend the day indulging in a culinary adventure on your own or choose an optional visit to the fishing village of Nazaré, set on a wide bay overlooking the Atlantic. This Choice Experience also includes a visit to Óbidos where you'll have time to explore the medieval walled city with its whitewashed houses and cobblestone lanes. Aside from its obvious charm and history that pre-dates the founding of Portugal, Óbidos is also home to the delightfully decadent Ginja cherry liqueur served up in tiny chocolate cups. Don't go home without a taste or two!

Charming Óbidos and Nazaré Discovery - Embark on a northern adventure with a Local Guide to the enchanting medieval town of Óbidos. Get lost in its ancient castle and towering walls, not to mention a taste of the famous cherry liquor, Ginjinha. Then, off you go to Nazaré, a surfer's paradise with the world's most colossal waves, before making a stop at the revered Sanctuary of Our Lady. Along the way, soak in breathtaking views. There's also free time to relax on the beach or browse the local shops before you head back to Lisbon.

Seafood Feast by the Tagus River - Gear up for an epic night out in Lisbon that kicks off with a ferry ride across the grand Tagus River. Enjoy a feast of Portuguese seafood and fish favorites at a local restaurant. Post-dinner, cruise over the Suspension Bridge for killer views of the Portuguese capital at night. On occasion, the ferry may not be available and you will travel over the bridge both ways.

Day 4 | Lisbon – Tomar – Fátima



Leave Lisbon behind, bound for the Templar city of Tomar for an orientation with your Travel Director, a beautiful reminder of Portuguese Renaissance. Continue to Fátima, a site of a celebrated religious miracle where three young shepherds are said to have seen an apparition of the Virgin Mary in 1917. Explore the Basilica and Sanctuary on your own before dinner at your hotel with your travel companions.

CHOICE OPTIONAL EXPERIENCES:

Monastery of Batalha Discovery - Take a historical deep dive with your Local Guide at the Monastery of Batalha, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Unpack the tales of the Aljubarrota Battle, gawk at the flashy Gothic architecture, and get the scoop on the tomb of the royal duo behind the world's longest-running diplomatic alliance—the Windsor Treaty. Cap it off with some free time to snag those souvenirs before you head back to the hotel.

Day 5 | Fátima – Coimbra – Porto



Travel to Coimbra to explore the city your way before continuing to Porto. Arrive in time for a sightseeing tour with a Local Specialist of the city's UNESCO-listed medieval Ribeira Quarter, the port and the remarkable bridges that span the Douro River. With an evening to do as you wish, you may be tempted to head to the water's edge and one of the city's Port wine cellars for a tasting and insights into the centuries-old tradition of local Port production.

Kick things off with a stroll through Mercado do Bolhao to sample the local delicacies. Next up, you'll dive into traditional Portuguese delights at a cosy restaurant. And for the grand finale? A stunning sunset at Jardim Do Morro, port wine in hand. It's not just a meal; it's a culinary adventure.
