Day 03 MADRID


Breakfast

Day 04 MADRID SEGOVIA SALAMANCA

Breakfast / Roast Suckling Pig Lunch

 Proceed to the old town of Segovia for a view of its Roman Aqueduct Bridge, both of which are listed as UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Taste the famous local specialty of Roast Suckling Pig, 'Cochinillo Asado' for lunch. En route, we will stop for photos at Avila, the most wellpreserved medieval city wall. Make a stop at Salamanca's Plaza Mayor, regarded as one of the finest squares in Europe.



Day 05 SALAMANCA PORTO

Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner-Piri Piri Chicken with Wine

 This morning, we shall cross the border into Porto, the 2nd largest city in Portugal and a UNESCO World Heritage City. Commence the guided city tour of Porto and see the Porto Cathedral, Igreja do Carmo, Aliados Ave and Dom Luis Bridge. You will get the chance to sample and savour world-famous Port Wine.

Day 06 PORTO FATIMA LISBON

Breakfast / Dinner

 Travel to Serra d' Aire Mountains to the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima, the worldrenowned centre of pilgrimage in the Catholic world. Tonight, we will stay the night in the capital of Portugal, Lisbon.

Day 07 LISBON

Breakfast / Portuguese Egg Tart Snack

 Lisbon's sightseeing starts with the broad avenues of the lower town and the alleys of the Alfama Quarter. View the Monument to the Discoveries, the Belem Tower and Jeronimos Monastery and not forgetting to stop for the everpopular snacks – Portuguese Egg Tarts. This afternoon, you may wish to consider joining an optional tour to visit Sintra, the westernmost point of continental Europe at Cabo Da Roca, and the charming fishing village of Cascais.

Day 08 LISBON SEVILLE

Breakfast / Lunch / Flamenco Dinner Show with Wine

Cross the border back into Spain to the capital of Andalusia - Seville, and see the immense 15th century gothic Seville Cathedral with its slender Giralda Tower. Walk through Maria Luisa Park to the beautiful square of Plaza de Espana. See the Jewish District of Santa Cruz with its flower-decked wrought iron balconies. Tonight, enjoy a fiery Flamenco Dinner Show with wine for an unforgettable experience of Spanish passion!

Day 09 SEVILLE A GRANADA

Breakfast / Dinner

 Today, you may wish to join an excursion to Cordoba, which was an important Roman city and a major Islamic centre during the Middle Ages. See the Mezquita de Cordoba

 the Mosque-Cathedral has been an important place to the Islamic community of Al-Andalus for 3 centuries. We will drive

 to the southern Spain's Andalusia region, **Granada**, in the foothills of Sierra Nevada Mountains. Enjoy its little streets and alleys, full of Andalusian atmosphere and character. Visit the exquisite **Alhambra Palace**, built by the Moorish rulers since the 13th century (Note: Entry is subject to opening days/times), then walk through the exotic water gardens of **Generalife**, the royal summer residence.

Day 10 GRANADA 🖨 VALENCIA

Breakfast / Seafood Paella Dinner

• This morning, we will drive through the Sierra Mountains en route to **Guadix**, best known as the 'City of Caves'. We will visit one of the cave houses in Guadix. Drive along the scenic coastline to **Valencia**, the 3rd largest city in Spain. Drive through the **old town of Valencia** and stop at the **City of Art and Sciences**, one of the largest scientific and cultural complexes in Europe.

Breakfast / Tapas Lunch with Sangria


